Two new designated testing clinics opening in the Laurentians

Given the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, the Centre intégré de santé et de services sociaux (CISSS) des Laurentides will be opening two new testing clinics in the Laurentians.

The Vallée de la Rouge and Argenteuil designated testing clinics will be open to the public starting on January 19. These clinics, where people will be able to go without needing an appointment, will be open two half-days a week. Their addresses and opening hours are available on the COVID-19 page of the CISSS des Laurentides website at santelaurentides.gouv.qc.ca.

"We are pleased to be improving access to this service for the citizens of Argenteuil and Rivière-Rouge, who until now had to travel several kilometres away to get tested.
