COVID-19 Vaccination

Booster doses are now available for seniors aged 70 and over as well as those who received the AstraZeneca or Covishield vaccine

Saint-Jérôme, November 22, 2021 – Starting now, seniors aged 70 and over who live at home can book an appointment to get a COVID-19 booster shot at the various vaccinations sites in the region. Individuals who received two doses of the AstraZeneca or Covishield vaccine can also get a booster short starting November 25.

An interval of at least six months must have elapsed since the last vaccine dose.

"Our vaccination sites are ready to serve targeted individuals who wish to receive a booster shot. Several time windows are available to accommodate the public at the times that suit them best », said the President and Executive Director of the Centre intégré de santé et de services sociaux (CISSS) des Laurentides, Mme Rosemonde Landry.

To book an appointment online visit Québec.ca/vaccinCOVID or use the NotifVAX mobile app. Persons lacking internet access or who have difficulty using it can call 1-877-644-4545 to obtain support. If necessary, family and friends are encouraged to help seniors make an appointment online. A free shuttle service is also available in the region for persons with reduced mobility who need to be accompanied or who lack transportation. To access this service, call 1-866-495-5833.
