COVID-19 vaccination Walk-in clinics resume for first doses

Saint-Jérôme, January 10, 2022 – The Centre intégré de santé et de services sociaux (CISSS) des Laurentides is announcing that vaccinations without an appointment will resume for the period from January 10 to 14, but ONLY for persons wishing to get their first dose of COVID-19 vaccine. This service is now available at all vaccination sites in the region. For information on scheduling and opening hours, visit the COVID-19 vaccination section at www.santelaurentides.gouv.qc.ca.

Persons who are eligible to receive their second dose or booster shot must for their part book an appointment with <u>Clic Santé</u>. As new time-slots are continually added, the public is asked to check the site regularly. "We hope this initiative will be an added incentive for people who may still be hesitant about getting vaccinated against COVID-19. All they need to do to receive a first dose of vaccine is to go to a vaccination site. No further action is required", said the President and Executive Director of the CISSS des Laurentides, Ms. Rosemonde Landry.

As a reminder, a free shuttle service is also available throughout the region for persons with reduced mobility and requiring accompaniment or who lack transportation to a vaccination site. To access this service, simply call 1-866-495-5833.
